Wisconsin associations representing public school teachers, principals, superintendents and school board members each to recognize Senator Kohl with top honors in 2024

MADISON, WI — The leaders of the state's largest public school teachers, principals, superintendents and school board member associations are joining together to recognize U.S. Senator Herb Kohl and honor his commitment to public education in Wisconsin.
